SUNDAY, JULY 12, 2026

Depart Minneapolis with a stop in Reykjavik, Iceland

We begin our exciting journey to the beautiful Alpine countries as we board our flight to Frankfurt. We will spend the next number of days enjoying the natural beauty, dynamic history and special traditions found in Germany, Austria, and Switzerland. IF.

MONDAY, JULY 13, 2026

ROTHENBURG

Upon arrival in Frankfurt, Germany, we meet our driver and depart immediately for Wurzburg, a city along the river Main surrounded by huge parks and vineyards. We will enjoy a short tour of the Residenz which is located in Wurzburg. This castle is the main work of south German Baroque and one of the most important castles in Europe. Since 1982, the Residenz has been included in the UNESCO World Heritage list. We then continue on to Rothenburg, one of Germany's greatest treasures, the city that time passed by. It is probably the best preserved medieval walled city in Germany. No one is allowed to change anything within the city walls which date back hundreds of years. D

TUESDAY, JULY 14, 2026

ROTHENBURG

This morning we will have a guided tour of Rothenburg which will acquaint us with this truly charming gem. As we admire the handsome, half-timbered building and walk the narrow, winding cobblestone streets and ramparts, we realize that we truly are stepping back over 500 years in time. Afterwards you will have time to relax if you wish, or simply stroll through the enchanting village, sit down at a sidewalk café, order a brats and a beer, and just enjoy the atmosphere of this old German city. You will find that this will be one of the best places to shop while on tour. B

WEDNESDAY, JULY 15, 2026

SALZBURG

We leave Rothenburg and drive to Salzburg, Austria, which is one of the most beautiful cities in Europe. After arrival we will take a walking tour of the "old" town and see some of the sights of the Sound of Music. The tour will also include the Mirabell Gardens, the mammoth cathedral and the famous Getreidegasse, a pedestrian shopping area. In the evening we will attend the very popular "Sound of Austria"



dinner show located in the old town. B/D

THURSDAY, JULY 16, 2026

SALZBURG

This morning we will take a very exciting bus ride to visit Hitler's Eagles Nest (Kehlstein), perched high above the city of Berchtesgaden. From the Eagle's Nest you will be treated to a spectacular view of the countryside below. The afternoon is free for you to explore Salzburg and spend some time shopping in the Getreidegasse. B/D

FRIDAY, JULY 17, 2026

OBERAMMERGAU



Today we leave Austria and travel back in to Germany to the beautiful Bavarian village of Oberammergau, where the famous Passion Play is held every ten years. On the way we will stop in Munich and walk through the famous Marienplatz where we can see the Glockenspiel on the new city hall and stop at the renowned Hofbrauhaus to listen to some music and have refreshments if you wish. SATURDAY, JULY 18, 2026

OBERAMMERGAU

Today we will visit Linderhof, another one of King Ludwig's castles. It is smaller than the famous Neuschwanstein but a much more ornate castle. We will return to Oberammergau where you will have a chance to relax and enjoy the German village and maybe shop for wood carvings, something for which this area and village is quite famous. B

SUNDAY, JULY 19, 2026

LUCERNE

We will be leaving Germany once again, this time traveling into the majestic country of Switzerland. On the way we will stop at Vaduz, the capital of Liechtenstein, for lunch and then continue on to Lucerne. Lucerne is the storybook image of a Swiss town, abounding in cobblestone streets, spires and turrets, covered bridges, frescoed houses and fountains. We will also see the famous Lion monument and the Chapel Bridge. B/D

MONDAY, JULY 20, 2026

LUCERNE

After breakfast we begin a full day excursion into the Swiss

Alps. We will drive to Stechelburg, just outside of Interlaken, and take a cable car to the Piz Gloria, a 360 degree solar powered revolving restaurant on the Schilthorn mountain peak, where we will have lunch. Excerpts from the James Bond film, "On Her Majesty's Secret Service" were shot on the Schilthorn. Tonight we will enjoy the Swiss folklore entertainment at the famous Stadtkeller in Lucerne. B/L/D

TUESDAY, JULY 21, 2026

BLACK FOREST

We will leave Switzerland and drive to Lake Konstanz on the border between Switzerland and Germany. There we will visit the famous tropical island of Mainau to see the very beautiful tropical gardens. From spring through to autumn, Mainau presents a magnificent view of and ever changing sea of flowers. We then continue for an overnight in Triberg in the Black Forest. B/D

WEDNESDAY, JULY 22, 2026

RUDESHEIM

This morning we first stop at an open-air "living" museum at Gutach in the Black Forest. Discover the world of the Black Forest farmers and see the way they lived and worked in impressive 16th to 19th century Black Forest farmhouses and mills. After the tour we continue on to Rudesheim, the most picturesque of the Rhineland "wine villages". B/D

THURSDAY, JULY 23, 2026

RUDESHEIM

This morning we cruise the Rheine, the granddaddy of the German waterways. A cruise on the most scenic segment of the Rheine River takes us past majestic medieval castles and fortifications perched high on the banks overlooking the river, picturesque villages with pointed church spires and countless immaculately kept vineyards. This afternoon we will visit the Marksburg castle, a castle virtually unchanged since medieval times. It is the only hill castle on the Rheine that has never been destroyed. In the afternoon we will be back in Rudesheim so you can do some last minute shopping, pack for your trip home and then in the evening, kick back and enjoy the world famous "Drosselgasse" with its many wine bars that offer live music and dancing. This is a perfect place for us to end our tour of the Alpine countries. B/D

FRIDAY, JULY 24, 2026

FRANKFURT/USA

Sadly, it is time for us to return to the good ol' USA. Our tour has been relaxing and filled with many wonderful memories.
